    - \*dollars received for hosting 2 bookfairs, dollars were about to expires Katherine went over the items purchased
  - f. Reflex-Math Program funding request
    - \*per Ms. Vahle the teachers want this item re-purchased to deal w/ the deficit caused by Covid. This program helps w/ this and they'd like the PTO to consider purchasing this. A letter was read from the teachers that stated this program is favored because it's game based the students find it more engaging. This program monitors each individual user progress and allow for more practice, enrichment and reinforcement. Higher usage has produced higher test scores, teachers are already seeing a decline without the program. Per Ms. Val, the rep stated the program is \$3,295 for 1-5th grade, there was a miscommunication about a price increase but that was with add ons included, the true price is \$3,295 and in the past PTO purchased it, but last year it likely came out of the school budget. Right now the teachers use the Freckle program that is paid for by the

district, but this is less preferred by the teachers. This was voted on the end of the year unanimously, but Ms. Vahle was not sure why the school did not move forward w/ the purchase.

\*per Katherine anything over \$1k has to be approved by the board and voted on at the general meeting, PTO and Dr. Bannister will speak about working together on this \* parents asked that this be fast past to expedite the process so the kids don't go w/out it too long...parents want an emergency meeting to get this done as soon as possible perDr. Bannister he will look at the budget and PTO will follow the bylaws to consider this purchase

- \* Lena has run the program for 2 years here at Moye, but has run into resistance from teachers and isn't sure if it's wanted for this year and has decided to resign
- \*Parents asked what the advertisement for this was like to get the parents involved. Lena's email to introduce the program was attached to the newsletter
- \*parents spoke about a cafeteria large group art program that ended after Covid.

  Parents and teachers stated that this was a better more organized way of doing it and allowed the teachers to avoid taking away too much time away from lesson plans

  \*parent recommended reaching out to McKendree or the Military to step in to volunteer, also grandparents etc, also recommended an email blast per Lena this is a great idea and worth looking in to
- \*Per Ms. Vahle the reluctancy is taking time away from testing needs of the older grades and recommended this being offered after school for enrichment
- \*parents mentioned access to an Airforce squadron looking for volunteer hours that would be an option to volunteer w/ GSWA
- \*we will look into this more and possibly bring this back in January
