We have provided a few ways to help make it easier to fill out your form. If you have any additional questions, please contact your school secretary.

1. The survey attached to this email should be downloaded so that you can type your information in the boxes OR print and hand write the information.
2. The signature must be a physical signature per Federal Impact Aid guidelines.
3. Be sure to date the form.
4. We are required to collect one form for EACH student.
5. Print the form and scan it to your school secretary. We can also accept photos but a scanned image is preferred due to clarity of the image. If you do send a photo, please send it as a medium size/resolution.
6. We can accept faxed forms, please send it to the attention of your school secretary. include your email address.

Commonly Asked Questions

Why do we annually distribute and collect the impact aid form?

The federal government wants to make sure schools serving the military are able to provide comprehensive services to the children of military members. The data collected from this form will be used in the District's Impact Aid Funding application. Last year, this brought in approximately \$265,000 that we used to support academics at District 90.

Can this form be done at registration?

No, per impact aid guidelines, we have to pick a date after the 4th date of school.

Does this hurt/harm our military members or their children?

No, funds we receive enable us to provide offerings to our students we wouldn't be able to afford otherwise.

Does the school need these funds?

District 90 is funded at 64% adequacy, per Illinois guidelines and funding formula. In other words, District 90 is funded at 64% of what is needed to fully educate the student body pursuant to our demographics. District 90 is in the lowest tier for educational funding, as defined by state calculations, and thus is in the greatest need of additional funding.

What does it mean by "employed on federal property?"

Anyone who works on Illinois federal property, whether classified as civilian or uniformed services. We have listed some properties on the form. A few examples would be – Contractor on base, TRANSCOM, AAFES or Burger King

I have multiple students. Do I need to complete the form for each student?

Yes, we will need one form per student.

I am not sure if my students qualify for Impact Aid. Should I still complete the form?

Yes, please complete the form.

Is there a deadline for completing this form?

Yes, the last day to complete the form is Friday, October 29th, 2021.
