It is simply families purchasing gift cards and receiving a percentage of that money back into an account to be used by their student for his or her 8th grade trip! It's easy and your profit adds up quickly if you use this program for your everyday expenses like food, clothing, and other essentials. How the Program Generates Revenue For You:

Instead of purchasing our gift cards directly from the retailer, our program purchases them from the Great Lake Scrip Center. Because the center purchases large amounts of gift cards for various fundraising groups, participating retailers offer a substantial discount.

Scrip is Very Easy!!

Scrip is a popular fundraiser because families don't have to sell anything. Families produce revenue for their student by making regular household purchases that they would make anyway. Groceries, clothing, toys, gifts, even gasoline can be purchased with the gift cards. Families can increase their revenue by giving gift cards for special occasions and by having additional family members order gift cards, as well.

For Example – On Your Next Scrip Order You Get:

1	Gap Gift Card	\$25.00
2	Macys Gift Cards (\$25 x 2)	\$50.00
2	Panera Gift Card (\$10 x 2)	\$20.00

You write a \$95.00 check, payable to Fulton Jr. High, and your child makes \$9.05 in his/her 8th Grade Trip account. If you're replacing the carpeting or making a large purchase at Lowes or Home Depot, your child's revenue could add up very quickly! Last year, some 8th grade families paid for their student's entire trip just by using this program!

How to Start?

Begin by adding your name to the Fulton Scrip Gift Card Program e-mail list to ensure you receive the order forms and updates. Approximately every other week during the school year an order form will be e-mailed to you. There is no obligation to order every time, but if you want to order, just complete the order form, write a check, and you or your student drop it off in the Fulton front office in the "Scrip" mailbox. The following week, your order will be delivered to your student during their last class, or held in the office for your pick up (if you prefer).
